



# HERITAGE FUNDING

## Heritage Legacy Fund, Heritage BC

- Yearly intake in the spring for Heritage Conservation, Heritage Awareness, and Indigenous Partnership streams. Applications for Heritage Planning accepted year-round.
- Registered non-profits, local governments, First Nations and school boards are eligible for funding.
- Funds 50% of eligible costs to a maximum of \$25,000 for Heritage Conservation, \$10,000 for Heritage Awareness, \$7,500 for Indigenous Partnerships and \$1,500 for Heritage Planning

## Various, Canadian Heritage

- Includes funding for museums, anniversaries, and capital projects, among other things.
- Funding levels vary, but some programs cover 100% of expenses up to a maximum amount
- Intakes happen throughout the year, see the individual program pages for dates and more information
- Eligible applicants vary, but some programs are open to non-profits, First Nations and local governments.

## Cultural Heritage Grants, First Peoples' Cultural Council

- Funding streams for oral history, micro-grants and land and language-based projects
- Funding provided up to a varying maximum amount from \$2,000 to \$25,000 depending on the program
- First Nations and non-profits that are Indigenous led are eligible for funding
- Deadlines are varied and occur throughout the year
